- **The award is open to individuals or groups with a genuine interest in horticulture.**
- **Examples of the award could be for a study tour, project or a piece of research work.**
- **This award is for £1000, of which £800 will be awarded throughout the project and the final £200 being given on completion.**
- **A fully planned and costed proposal must be submitted by the closing date of 1st September.**
- **The project must be completed within 12 months of the award being granted.**
- **Candidates may be required to attend an interview to present their proposal.**
- **All proposals submitted will be acknowledged.**
- **A decision will be made by 1st October and candidates will then be notified of the decision.**
- **The successful applicant will be required to present the proposal at the October meeting of the Kent Horticultural Bursary, and then present a full report of the completed project the following year.**
